- 1. <u>Policy Change Proposal for Foster Care Grants:</u> Staff will outline a proposal to change eligibility requirements for children and families served in PCL-funded foster care programs. Two foster care program grantee partners and a staff person from the Oregon Department of Human Services Child Welfare will speak in support of the proposed change. **Action:** Committee questions, discussion, public comment, and vote.
